

# Patient Guide to getting registered on the NHS APP

### Download the NHS APP:

- 1. Open App Store or Google Play and search for the "NHS App"
- 2. This is what the NHS App will look like, click install

### Getting Registered

- 1. Once downloaded, it will show on your home screen, click the app to open
- 2. When you first open the App, you will see this screen, click on the white box on the bottom of the screen
- 3. Enter your email address and press continue

- If you do not have an NHS log-in, after pressing continue, you will be asked if you want to set up a new NHS Login. Press "continue"
- 5. Enter a new password, then enter it again and press continue

- You will then receive an email from "NHS Login" with a security code
- Go back to the APP, once you have viewed your security code and enter it in the box shown
- 8. Once you press continue, you will be asked to add your mobile number. Again you will receive a security code through a text message, once you have entered your number
- 9. Read the security number and enter it in the box on the app and press continue
- 10. You are now registered onto the app!
